Program Overview

Three Years to Make an Eternal Impact

The Launch program is specifically designed to expose participants to all aspects of what is required to be an effective cross-cultural Gospel worker. It accomplishes this by deploying cohorts of three to six people for 2 years to work alongside some of GEM's most effective missionaries in a variety of strategic locations. You can expect to receive customized training in fund raising, discipleship, church planting, community development and in some cases language learning. In addition to the structured training programs and curated ministry opportunities, each cohort will be hosted by a dedicated mentor couple or team whose goal is to personalize the experience for you and help you become as effective as possible. While this program is designed as a structured 2-year missions experience, those who feel God's further call on their lives can transition to full time service at numerous points along the way.


Program Snapshot:

So let me try to paint you a picture of what you can expect in Kandern, Germany. Kandern is located near Switzerland and France and lies in southern Germany because of its location we have many different ministry opportunities that can be presented to you.

Located right here in Kandern is Black Forest Academy. Close to 300 students attend here each year and there is always something to do whether you enjoy leading small groups or helping with sports. There's a wide range of activities. However, working with junior high and high school students isn't for everyone. Some other ministry opportunities include working with local churches, getting involved with local ministries or joining a local club and doing relational evangelism. Germans are very big on being in a club and there is a club for everything. Another opportunity is working with the many refugees in this area. There are several missionaries here who are trying to organize different services and opportunities to connect with the immigrants. Right now we have both Syrian and Ukrainian immigrants in our area. As you can see Kandern can offer a great view of what being a missionary is like. It's a wonderful place to get your feet wet and be stretched by God in the process.
